Pursuant to Utah Code Ann., § 19-1-301.5 and Utah Admin. Code R305-7-201 *et seq.*, on June 10, 2015, the Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) in the above referenced permit review adjudicative proceeding, issued a decision recommending the entry of an order dismissing the pending construction permit review adjudicative proceeding.


Under authority of Utah Code Ann., § 19-1-301(7) and 19-1-301.5(13), when an ALJ submits a recommended dispositive action, I may: 1) adopt it; 2) adopt it with modifications; 3) reject it; or 4) or return it to the ALJ for further action as required; and

Having reviewed the ALJ’s Recommended Order Dismissing Proceedings and for the reasons more fully described in the Petitioner’s Consolidated Voluntary Motion to Dismiss Appeals, and the Respondents having no objection, I adopt the Recommended Decision in full.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Petitioner’s Request for Agency Action (Construction Permit) be dismissed with prejudice, terminating these adjudicative proceedings.
