Funding Available to Convert Wood Stoves to Gas or Electric in 2020

SALT LAKE CITY – The Utah Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has released the 2020 registration schedule for the overwhelmingly popular grant program to convert operating wood-burning fireplaces to cleaner burning natural gas or electric.

On-line registration will take place across the Wasatch Front and Cache Valley.

The schedule is posted on the DEQ's webpage, stoves.utah.gov.

Thousands of dollars in grants are available for homeowners who wish to participate in the wood smoke reduction program. Conversion from wood to gas heating can reduce emissions by as much as 100 times less.
