Entry Point Sampling Plan

In order to ensure that all of the sources in an entry point grouping are active at the time of sampling the water system must submit to DDW a sampling plan that shows the sources in the group source sampling station, their operational periods, and planned dates of sampling. If a source for a particular entry point goes inactive for more than one year the system will notify DDW.

Phase II/V sampling refers to samples taken for: nitrate, nitrite, inorganics and metals, sodium/sulfate/tds, volatile organics, pesticides, and radionuclides.

The Rules Services section will review the entry point submittal and decide if the system qualifies for entry point sampling.
