



**PUBLIC NOTICE of COMPLETION**  
**Five-Year-Review of Murray Smelter Superfund Site**  
**Murray City, Salt Lake County, Utah**



**Summary: Fourth Five-Year Review Completed**

The Utah Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Environmental Response and Remediation (UDEQ/DERR), and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 8 have completed the fourth Five-Year Review for the Murray Smelter Superfund Site. Five-year reviews are required by the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) when hazardous substances remain on site above levels that permit unrestricted use and unlimited exposure. Five-Year reviews are conducted to evaluate the site remedy and to determine whether site conditions remain protective of human health and the environment.

**Protectiveness Statement:** EPA has determined in the Five-Year Review the cleanup at the Murray Smelter Site is protective. This means that the implemented remedy is protective of human health and the environment and allows for commercial reuse. Murray City staff inspects and monitors the site as required under the Smelter Site Overlay District (SSOD) ordinance for all of the properties located within the site including Costco Wholesale Warehouse, Intermountain Medical Center, and Utah Transit Authority. The Division of Environmental Response and Remediation (DERR) meets with City representatives on a regular basis to discuss and answer questions related to new construction development and compliance with the SSOD. This Five-Year Review Report was signed August 14, 2019.
