



PUBLIC NOTICE of COMPLETION
Five-Year Review of the
Utah Power & Light (UP&L)-American Barrel Superfund Site
Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, Utah



Summary: Fifth Five-Year Review Completed

The Utah Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Environmental Response and Remediation (UDEQ/DERR), and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 8, have completed the fifth Five-Year Review for the Utah Power & Light (UP&L)-American Barrel Superfund Site. Five-Year Reviews are required by the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) when hazardous substances remain on site above levels that permit unrestricted use and unlimited exposure. Five-Year Reviews are conducted to evaluate the site remedy and to determine whether site conditions remain protective of human health and the environment.

Protectiveness Statement: The EPA has determined in the Five-Year Review the determination regarding the current protectiveness of the remedy at the Utah Power & Light (UP&L)-American Barrel Superfund Site has been deferred until a vapor intrusion investigation can be completed at the site. The available data is insufficient to determine whether there is a potential or actual risk for exposure resulting from the vapor intrusion exposure pathway. Plume boundaries, groundwater concentration levels, and mitigation systems within the building are currently being evaluated by the EPA and the UDEQ to determine the sampling necessary to complete the vapor intrusion investigation. Long and short-term protectiveness determinations cannot be made until additional data to characterize the risks posed by the vapor intrusion pathway is obtained. This Five-Year Review Report was signed September 23, 2021 and the next Five-Year Review is required five years from the completion date.
