PUBLIC NOTICE of COMPLETION
Five-Year Review of the Petrochem/Ekotech Superfund Site
Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, Utah



Summary: Second Five-Year Review Completed

The Utah Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Environmental Response and Remediation (UDEQ/DERR), and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 8, have completed the second Five-Year Review for the Petrochem/Ekotech Superfund Site. Five-Year Reviews are required by the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) when hazardous substances remain on site above levels that permit unrestricted use and unlimited exposure. Five-Year Reviews are conducted to evaluate the site remedy and to determine whether site conditions remain protective of human health and the environment.

Protectiveness Statement: The EPA has determined the remedy implemented at the Petrochem/Ekotech Superfund Site currently protects human health and the environment. Protectiveness of human health and the environment has been ensured by removing contaminated soil and treatment of groundwater. Institutional controls (ICs) are in place with an environmental covenant with Salt Lake County which only allows industrial use for the Site.

This Five-Year Review Report was signed September 23, 2021 and the next Five-Year Review is required five years from the completion date.
