



PUBLIC NOTICE of COMPLETION
Five-Year Review of the
Wasatch Chemical Company (Lot 6) Superfund Site
Salt Lake County, Utah



Summary: Sixth Five-Year Review Completed

The Utah Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Environmental Response and Remediation (UDEQ/DERR), and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 8, have completed the sixth Five-Year Review for the Wasatch Chemical Company (Lot 6) Superfund Site. Five-Year Reviews are required by the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) when hazardous substances remain on site above levels that permit unrestricted use and unlimited exposure. Five-Year Reviews are conducted to evaluate the site remedy and to determine whether site conditions remain protective of human health and the environment.

Protectiveness Statement: The EPA has determined the remedy implemented at the Wasatch Chemical Company (Lot 6) Superfund Site currently protects human health and the environment because there are no completed exposure pathways to waste that remains at the Site. For the remedy to be protective over the long term, the following action needs to be taken: use the remedy selection process to select an updated groundwater remedy, evaluate whether additional parcels need land-use restrictions, and evaluate whether additional soil activities may be beneficial to the groundwater remedy. The EPA will consider formally adding vinyl chloride as a Contaminate of Concern and the Potentially Responsible Party should prepare an updated Operations and Maintenance Plan to include annual vapor intrusion evaluations.

This Five-Year Review Report was signed September 26, 2022 and the next Five-Year Review is required five years from the completion date.
