*Utah Department of Environmental Quality
Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP)*

The public is invited to provide comment on a Remedial Action Plan that describes mitigation activities related to residual ore and tailings from historical operations at the former Antimony Mill located in Antimony Canyon about 5.5 miles to the east of the town of Antimony in unincorporated Garfield County, Utah (Site). The Site has been impacted by past uses and mitigation actions to minimize potential human and environmental exposures to potential contaminants include excavating residual ore piles, mill tailings, and impacted soil; and transporting and disposing of these materials at a permitted facility. Mitigation actions will be carried out by The Richard William Davis Trust, the applicant of record to the VCP.
