BACKGROUND

Brigham City has modified its local limits. The changes could impact industrial dischargers discharging to the Brigham City publicly owned treatment works.

A public hearing can be requested but must be filed during the 30 day comment period which will end on August 25, 2016. A request for a public hearing must be filed as per 40 CFR 403.11. After considering public comments the Utah Division Water Quality may approve the local limits, revise them, or abandon them. The Utah Division Water Quality will not publish a notice of decision provided that Brigham City's local limits will be approved without any changes to the local limits and no comments are received during the public comment period.
