PUBLIC NOTICE OF RENEWAL OF UPDES PERMIT

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO DECLARE THE STATE OF UTAH'S INTENTION TO REISSUE A UTAH POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (UPDES) PERMIT UNDER AUTHORITY OF THE UTAH WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ACT, SECTION 19-5-104(9) AND 107(2), UTAH CODE ANNOTATED 1953, AS AMENDED. SAID "PERMIT" REFERS TO THE UPDES PERMIT AND THE STATEMENT OF BASIS (INCLUDING TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOADS (TMDL'S)) IF APPLICABLE, AS PER SECTION 303(D) OF THE FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT (CWA)].

BACKGROUND

The Cedar City Wastewater Reclamation Facility (CCWRF) consists of one mechanical rotomat, one manual barscreen, two aerated grit chambers, two primary clarifiers, two trickling filters, two final clarifiers. Two anaerobic digesters, two chlorine contact basins, and sixteen drying beds. The facility has an influent design flow of 4.4 MGD. CCWRF services Cedar City, Enoch City, and Iron County. The CCWRF is located at latitude 37° 48' 36" and longitude 113° 05' 25"
