Subject: DU rule

Sadly, I will not be able to attend the meeting of the RCB tomorrow afternoon, so I want to convey my comments about DU to you.

My point of view is simple. I do not think the Utah site at Clive is the right place for this highly dangerous byproduct of uranium enrichment or re-processing. I believe the RCB has an opportunity to put teeth into the protection of Utah and the people ahead of us by instituting a new rule that would require ANY storage or disposal to be sufficiently effective to protect future generations from radiological exposure or damage. The Texas model of utilizing "peak dose" is a conservative position. Please be VERY conservative as you design a rule to protect Utah.
