Public Notice of Intent to Renew Ground Water
Discharge Permit No. UGW270001**

Purpose of Public Notice

The Utah Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) is soliciting comments on the intent to renew a ground water discharge permit described below under authority of the Utah Water Quality Act, Section 19-5-108(1)(2) Utah Code Ann. 1953, as amended and Utah Administrative Code R317-6. Under Section 19-1-301.5, effective May 8, 2012, a person who wishes to challenge a Permit Order may only raise an issue or argument during an adjudicatory proceeding that was raised during the public comment period and was supported with sufficient information or documentation to enable the Director to fully consider the substance and significance of the issue. Facility Location:	The tailings pond and permitted facilities are located approximately 10 miles northeast of Delta, in Millard County, Utah.

Groundwater Discharge Permit No.UGW270001 is being renewed for the existing Facility and Tailings Pond owned by Materion Natural Resources (formerly Brush Resources). All plant wastewater and tailings are disposed of in a 220-acre tailings pond at the plant site. This tailings pond has received all of the liquid wastes from the mill facility since 1969. A Discharge Minimization Technology (DMT) has been approved to reduce the seepage rate and to protect groundwater from potential contamination.

Public Comments
