Who May File A Notice Of Termination (NOT) Form

Permittees who are presently covered under the State issued Utah Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (UPDES) General Storm Water Permit for Construction Activity may submit a notice of termination (NOT) form when their facilities no longer have any storm water discharges associated with industrial activity as defined in the storm water regulations at UAC R317-8-3.9(6)(d)10 or (e)1, or when they are no longer the operator of the facilities.

For construction activities, elimination of all storm water discharges associated with industrial activity occurs when disturbed soils at the construction site have been finally stabilized and temporary erosion and sediment control measures have been removed or will be removed at an appropriate time, or that all storm water discharges associated with construction activity from the construction site that are authorized by a UPDES general permit have otherwise been eliminated. Final stabilization means that all soil-disturbing activities at the site have been completed, and that a uniform perennial vegetative cover with a density of 70% has been established on all unpaved areas and areas not already covered by permanent structures, or equivalent permanent stabilization measures (such as the use of riprap, gabions, or geotextiles) have been employed.

Section I – Permit/Site Information

Enter the existing UPDES Storm Water General Permit number assigned to the facility or site identified in Section III. If you do not know the permit number, contact the Division of Water Quality at (801) 536-4300. Answer all questions and provide information concerning other responsible parties if applicable. Where another party assumes responsibility over a portion of the site, you must show in the SWPPP for the site appropriate documentation of the date and the area of the site involved in the transfer of responsibility.

Section II - Facility Operator Information

There may be more than one operator (e.g. including a co-permittee or co-permittees) for a construction project. This form must be filled out and submitted by each of the operators listed on the notice of **intent** (NOI) that was submitted for receiving coverage under this permit. In this section give the legal name of the person, firm, public organization, or any other entity that is filed as an operator at the facility or site described in this application that desires to terminate coverage. The operator of the facility is the legal entity which controls the facility's operation (referring to operation of construction activity) or a portion of it, rather that the plant or site manager of the finished or rehabilitated facility. Do not use a colloquial name. Enter the complete address and telephone number of the operator. If there are more than one operators additional NOT forms must be filled out and submitted with those operators including the required information and signatures.

Section III - Facility/Site Location Information

Enter the facility's or site's official or legal name and complete address, including city, state and ZIP code and the latitude and longitude of the facility to the nearest 15 seconds of the approximate center of the site.

Section IV - Certification

State statues provide for severe penalties for submitting false information on this application form. State regulations require this application to be signed as follows:

For a corporation: by a responsible corporate officer, which means: (I) president, secretary, treasurer, or vice-president of the corporation in charge of a principal business function, or any other person who performs similar policy or decision making functions, or (ii) the manager of one or more **manufacturing**, production, or operating facilities employing more than 250 persons or having gross annual sales or expenditures exceeding \$25 million (in second-quarter 1980 dollars), if authority to sign documents has been assigned or delegated to the manager in accordance with corporate procedures; or by a duly authorized representative (See permit part 5.16.1.b. for a definition of duly authorized representative).

For a partnership or sole proprietorship: by a general partner or the proprietor, respectively; or

For a municipality, State, Federal, or other public facility: by either a principal executive officer or ranking elected official.
