

HTC America, Inc. ("HTC") hereby submits its annual recycling report as required by Section 19-6-1203 of the Utah Code. HTC is a manufacturer of consumer electronic devices under the statute. We maintain a mail-back recovery plan as a means for Utah consumers to properly and safely dispose of their old or unwanted electronic devices at no cost.

The HTC recycling program is reasonably convenient and available to Utah consumers. Consumers can download a free shipping label online and return their obsolete electronic equipment to HTC for responsible recycling. HTC accepts, at no charge, covered devices that are labeled with the HTC brand as well as any other mobile phone, smartphone, or tablet computer, regardless of its condition or manufacturer. HTC publishes information about our mail-back recovery plan at the HTC recycling program website, www.freeurecycle.com.

When consumers mail in old electronic equipment, HTC's ISO 14001-certified partner, The Wireless Source, either refurbishes the devices for reuse or recycles them in a manner consistent with ISRI's Electronic Recycling Operating Practices and EPA's Responsible Recycling Practices.
