Utah Radiation Control Board (URCB) Action:

Moratorium On Disposal of Depleted Uranium Low-Level Radioactive Waste.

The Board passed a motion to table the discussion of a moratorium until after the Board meets with the NRC.



August, 2009:

NRC RECOMMEND INTERIM ACTION:

A facility disposing DU should develop a site specific PA which should be evaluated against criteria in SECY-08-0147 prior to disposal of large quantities of DU.



September, 2009:

EnergySolutions (ES) submits amendment to Radioactive Material License (RML) for DU disposal:

- (a) Burial Depth
- (b) Performance Assessment
- (c) Redesign
- (d) Financial Surety



September, 2009:

Utah Radiation Control Board Action:

Motion passed to insert specific requirements for DU disposal into EnergySolution's RML.



October, 2009: Utah Radiation Control Board Action:

URCB considers and votes to make changes to the License requirements for Depleted Uranium disposal at EnergySolutions.

Motion passed 8 Yes's; 1 No; and 1 Abstention

In addition, the Board is in favor of requiring a PA and to have the PA approved by the Executive Secretary before DU is accepted.



November, 2009 Utah Radiation Control Board Action:

Motion to rescind the actions of the Board in October 2009; and accept the License amendment as was submitted to the Board in September 2009; and to enter a Rulemaking Procedure to adopt those changes made during the October 2009 Board meeting with a draft document for the Board's December 2009 Meeting.

Motion Passed 9 Yes's; and 1 Abstention



December, 2009:

Utah Radiation Control Board Action:

URCB approves changes to

R313-25-8 requiring DU Performance Assessment and approval by the Executive Secretary before disposal.



 December 2009 – Proposed DU rule filed with the Division of Administrative Rules.

 January 2010 – Proposed DU rule out for 30 day Public Comment Period (January 1, 2010 to February 2, 2010).

Public Hearing held January 26, 2010.



 84 written comments were received during the 30 day public comment period.

 15 verbal comments were received during the public hearing.
