Dear Mr. Shrum:

On April 20, 2011, EnergySolutions submitted a temporary authorization request. Due to increased precipitation over the past year, several facility evaporation tanks are at capacity. The annual tank integrity inspections for Tanks 0225 and 0250 are due by April 26, 2011. EnergySolutions has requested a two-month extension to the inspection deadline.

EnergySolutions justified the request in accordance with 40 CFR 270.42 (e)(3)(ii)(D) where a facility needs to respond to changes in the quantities of waste (water) at the site.

The justification for the temporary authorization has been reviewed and is hereby approved. During the approval period, the facility will be required to remove the water from the tanks to prepare them for inspection.
