The proposed variance to License Conditions 16.A. would allow certain Class A sealed sources to be disposed in the Containerized Waste Facility (CWF) part of the Licensee's Clive facility for a period of one year. The variance will have a term of one year (365 days) from the date the first shipment is received under this variance. In addition, the Licensee will track and report the total number, volume, and activity of sources received and the serial numbers or other unique identification number of each source disposed under this variance. This report will be due no later than 3 months after the variance expiration date.
