RE: Inspection of the Escalante Class IVb Landfill

Dear Mayor Porter:

On, May 21, 2013, a representative of the Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste conducted an inspection of the Escalante Class IVb Landfill. The purpose of the inspection was to determine compliance with the Utah Solid Waste Permitting and Management Rules and the landfill permit. Enclosed is a copy of the inspection checklist and copies of the photographs taken during the inspection. The facility was found to be in compliance with the Solid Waste Rules and the Permit in the areas covered by the inspection with one exception.

The waste cell used for disposal of dead animals (see enclosed photograph) contained one animal carcass. It appeared that the animal had been placed there just prior to the inspection. The animal had not been covered with the required six inches of soil. As the landfill was closed and no operator was onsite, it was apparent that the required daily cover was not going to be placed. Daily cover needs to be done each day when animals are placed into the cell. Please review the permit requirements with the landfill operator and ensure that procedures are in place to comply with the permit.

Also, a few mattresses are piling up onsite. These need to be transported to the Johns Valley Class I landfill. Please call Brian Bremner, Garfield County Engineer, at (435) 690-1050 to arrange for removal of the waste mattresses to an approved landfill.
