Subject: Logan City Landfill Inspections

Dear Mr. Hamud:

On September 15, 2008, Matt Sullivan of the Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste inspected the Logan City Class I and Class IVb Landfills. We appreciate the cooperation and assistance from you and your landfill manager, Mr. John Christiansen.

The operation of both landfills was very good and the required records were complete. Areas outside of the landfill operations such as recycling, household hazardous waste, composting, and gatehouse monitoring were well-managed. Landfill records such as daily logs, quarterly inspections, random inspections, and ongoing monitoring were reviewed and in compliance with permit requirements.

The working face at the Class I landfill was properly managed and well-controlled by the operator. The working face at the Class IV construction and demolition (C&D) landfill was wider than usually seen - approximately 70 feet. As discussed with Mr. Christiansen at the C&D landfill, a smaller working face is usually suggested and often allows better control and site management. The size of the working face should reflect the most efficient landfill operation for both serving the public and managing the waste. Please monitor the working face at the Class IVb landfill over the next few weeks to determine whether expanded size is advantageous to the over all management of the site and make adjustments if necessary.

The Logan City landfills continue to be in compliance with the conditions of the current permits and requirements of the Solid Waste Permitting and Management Rules for the areas inspected. If you have questions, please call Matt Sullivan or Ralph Bohn at 801-538-6170.
