# **Purpose of Public Notice**

The Utah Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) is soliciting comments on the request to issue a ground water discharge permit as described below. The ground water discharge permit is issued by the Director of the Division of Water Quality under authority of the Utah Water Quality Act, Section 19-5-106(g) Utah Code Ann. 1953, as amended and Utah Administrative Code R317-6. Under Section 19-1-301.5, effective May 8, 2012, a person who wishes to challenge a Permit Order may only raise an issue or argument during an adjudicatory proceeding that was raised during the public comment period and was supported with sufficient information or documentation to enable the Director to fully consider the substance and significance of the issue. Norbest will construct and operate a 15 million gallon anaerobic lagoon as part of the operation and treatment of Moroni Waste Water Treatment Plant. The WWTP currently receives industrial wastewater from the Norbest turkey processing plant and sanitary wastewater from the City of Moroni. The lagoon will partially treat and equalize wastewater flows from the processing plant, thereby reducing the loading and allow for constant flow into the WWTP. This Ground Water Discharge Permit will require ground and process water compliance monitoring in addition to periodic testing of the lagoon liner as permit compliance conditions.

Public comments are invited any time prior to **Monday**, **June 13**, **2016**. Written comments may be directed to the Division of Water Quality, P.O. Box 144870, Salt Lake City, UT 84114-4870. All comments received prior to close of business **Monday**, **June 13**, **2016**, will be considered in the formulation of final determinations to be imposed on the permit. A public hearing may be held if written requests are received within the first 15 days of this public comment period that demonstrate significant public interest and substantive issues exist to warrant holding a hearing.
