RE: Cedar Valley Class VI Landfill Inspection

Dear Mr. Johnston:

The Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste inspected the Cedar Valley Class VI Landfill on June 29, 2011. The purpose of the inspection was to determine if the landfill operation was in compliance with both the Solid Waste Rules and the landfill permit. Mr. Calvin Thurston, Landfill Supervisor, accompanied the inspector and was most helpful.

During the inspection, several loads of construction and demolition waste were observed being unloaded. A bed mattress was also noted in the landfill face. Mr. Thurston indicated mattresses are seen infrequently in loads of construction and demolition waste. Please make every effort to ensure that only waste allowed under the rules and the permit are disposed. We commend you for maintaining the storage dumpster on the working face to accumulate metals for recycling.

At the time of the inspection, the landfill was determined to be in compliance with the rules and the permit.
