PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO DECLARE THE STATE OF UTAH'S INTENTION TO REISSUE A UTAH POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (UPDES) PERMIT UNDER AUTHORITY OF THE UTAH WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ACT, SECTION 19-5-104(9) AND 107(2), UTAH CODE ANNOTATED 1953, AS AMENDED. SAID "PERMIT" REFERS TO THE UPDES PERMIT AND THE FACT SHEET STATEMENT OF BASIS (INCLUDING TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOADS (TMDL'S)) IF APPLICABLE, AS PER SECTION 303(D) OF THE FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT (CWA)].

BACKGROUND

The facility serves the City of Orem, the City of Lindon, and a portion of the Town of Vineyard. The average design flow is 13.5 MGD, with a design population equivalent of 135,000. The facility is located at 1797 West 1000 South in Orem City, Utah County, Utah latitude 40°16'39" and longitude 111°44'19", with STORET Number 499525. The City of Orem has modified the disinfection at the wastewater treatment plant from chlorine to UV. Due to the modification, the City of Orem will no longer be required to sample for chlorine. Orem's City permit includes Pretreatment, Biosolids and Storm Water components.
