Pursuant to the provisions of the *Utah Solid and Hazardous Waste Act*, Title 19, Chapter 6, Part 1, Utah Code Annotated (UCA) 1953, as amended (the Act) and the *Utah Solid Waste Permitting and Management Rules*, Utah Administrative Code (UAC) R315-301 through 320 adopted thereunder,

Salt Lake City and Salt Lake County as joint permit owners and operators

are hereby approved to operate the SLVSWMF Class I Landfill located in east ½ of Section 10 and the west ¾ of Section 11 and south of the Union Pacific Railroad right of way, Township 1 south, Range 2 west, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, Salt Lake County, Utah as shown in the permit renewal application that was determined complete on July 9, 2009. The full legal description for the parcels that describe this property is located in Appendix A of the permit renewal application

The operation of the landfill is subject to the conditions that Salt Lake City and Salt Lake County (Permittee) meet the requirements of UAC R315-301 through 320 and the requirements set forth herein.


All references to UAC R315-301 through 320 are to regulations that are in effect on the date that this permit becomes effective.

This permit shall become effective January 15, 2010.

This permit shall expire at midnight January 14, 2020.

Closure Cost Revision Date: January 15, 2015.
