Purpose of Public Notice

The Utah Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) is soliciting comments on the request to modify a ground water discharge permit and issue an associated construction permit as described below. The ground water discharge permit is issued by the Director of the Division of Water Quality under authority of the Utah Water Quality Act, Section 19-5-106(g) Utah Code Ann. 1953, as amended and Utah Administrative Code R317-6. The construction permit is issued under authority of the Utah Water Quality Act, Section 19-5-106(2)(f), Utah Code Ann. 1953, as amended and Utah Administrative Code R317-1-2.2. Under Section 19-1-301.5, effective May 8, 2012, a person who wishes to challenge a Permit Order may only raise an issue or argument during an adjudicatory proceeding that was raised during the public comment period and was supported with sufficient information or documentation to enable the Director to fully consider the substance and significance of the issue. Sawtooth NGLs Caverns LLC (fna Magnum) is constructing a Natural Gas Liquids Storage Facility (Project) in Millard County, Utah approximately 10 miles north of Delta. The Project entails solution mining storage caverns in a subsurface salt deposit for the purpose of storing propane and butane. The resulting brine from the solution mining process is stored in an above ground lined pond for evaporation. The Project lies within an approximately 750-acre site located on Utah School and Institutional Trust Lands Administration (SITLA) lands. This Ground Water Discharge Permit amendment and construction permit is for adding a second brine evaporation pond and ground water compliance monitoring wells.
