## DIVISION OF WATER QUALITY UTAH DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY PUBLIC NOTICE TO REISSUE A UPDES PERMIT

#### PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

The purpose of this public notice is to declare the State of Utah's intention to issue a Utah Pollution Discharge Elimination System (UPDES) Permit under authority of the Utah Water Pollution Control Act, Section 19-5-104(9) and 107(2), Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended. Said "permit" refers to the UPDES Permit and the Fact Sheet Statement of Basis (including Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDL's)) if applicable, as per Section 303(d) of the Federal Clean Water Act (CWA)].

The facility serves the City of Spanish Fork with an average design flow of 5 MGD. The facility is located at 2160 North 150 East in Spanish Fork, Utah County, Utah, latitude 40° 18' 43" and longitude 111° 35' 54". The State of Utah Database Storet number is 499602. The permit has Biosolids, Multi-Sector Storm water and Pretreatment components.
