Any particular exam may be taken on only *one* of the two dates – *either* March 3, 2017, at the Rural Water Association of Utah (RWAU) Annual Conference in St. George, *OR* on April 6, 2017, at one of the other locations (North Salt Lake, Ogden, Vernal, or Utah Co. Health & Justice Bldg. in Provo). *Note: If there is enough demand, an April exam may be scheduled for the southern part of the state. Please contact us BEFORE submitting your application, if you wish to be considered for an alternate southern location in April.*

received at the Division of Water Quality office by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 3,

of exam and location you requested. Time allotted to take the exam is three (3) hours, in compliance with ABC's testing recommendations. No additional time is allowed if you choose to take more

than one exam during a session.

**TO APPLY:** Submit a fully completed exam application, notarized Citizenship/Alien ID Certification

form with copy of photo ID (if not previously submitted), and the \$50.00/exam fee payable by cash, check, money order, or *credit/debit cards* (*on-line payments are now available*).


