Endangered June Sucker

- One of 13 native fish of Utah Lake
- Pelagic feeder
- Spawns in Utah Lake tributaries
- Listed as endangered in 1986
- Threats included:
 - Modifications to spawning habitat
 - Introduced species (predators and competitors)
 - Loss of refuge habitat







JSRIP Organization

- Cooperative effort between state, federal, and local agencies
 - U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service
 - Utah Department of Natural Resources
 - Utah Reclamation, Mitigation, and Conservation Commission
 - U.S. Department of Interior, CUPCA Office

 - Central Utah Water Conservancy District

Ecosystem Approach to Recovery







Carp Removal












Removal Objectives

- Population estimate: 7.5 million age-2+ carp
- Remove over 5 million pounds per year
- 75% reduction in 6 years
