Re: Written Comments on Cavanagh Services Group, Inc. Proposed Radioactive
Material License Number UT 1800510

Dear Mr. Finerfrock:

EnergySolutions appreciates the ability to comment on Cavanagh Services Group, Inc. Proposed Radioactive Material License Number UT 1800510. We understand that the public comment period ends June 2, 2008.

EnergySolutions has one comment regarding License Condition 9B. License Condition 9B authorizes Cavanagh Services to possess radioactive material as a result of incidental contamination in or on shipping containers or conveyances on Section 32, Township 1 South and Range 11 West, Tooele County, UT. Currently, Cavanagh Services has a Container Storage Agreement ("Agreement") with EnergySolutions which allows them to store containers at the Clive facility. This Agreement neither allows nor implies permission to possess radioactive materials on Section 32. We believe that the inclusion of Section 32 into Cavanagh's License may be misconstrued as permission to manage radioactive materials. Therefore, EnergySolutions requests that any references to Section 32 be removed from the proposed license; leaving the area south of I-80 for Cavanagh to conduct licensed activities.
