PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

The purpose of this public notice is to declare the state of Utah's intention to reissue a Utah Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (UPDES) General Permit under authority of the Utah Water Pollution Control Act, Section 19-5-104(9) and 107(2), Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended. Said "permit" refers to the UPDES permit and the statement of basis (including total maximum daily loads (TMDL's) if applicable, as per section 303(d) of the Federal Clean Water Act (CWA).

BACKGROUND

Utah Administrative Code (UAC) Section R317-8-2.5 authorizes the issuance of general permits to categories of point sources within the same geographical area, which involve similar types of operations, discharge the same types of wastes, and require similar effluent limitations and pollution control measures. This general permit will cover discharges of treated ground water from gas station type facilities with Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) code 5541 and National American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code 447110.
