Appliance Pilot Light Regulations

Box Elder, Cache, Davis, Salt Lake, Tooele, Utah, and Weber Counties

Continuously lit pilot lights are a source of nitrogen oxide and fine particulate matter pollution. To reduce this source of pollution, no person shall manufacture for sale, distribute offer for sale or install in residential, institutional, and commercial any natural gas-fired fan-type central furnaces, fireplaces, stoves, and cooktops with a continuous pilot light after January 1, 2014. Units using fuel other than natural gas, intermittent pilot ignition, recreational vehicles and units manufactured and sold in Box Elder, Cache, Davis, Salt Lake, Weber, and Utah counties that are for shipment and use outside of those counties are exempt.
