Dear Mayor Allen:

The 30-day public comment period for the Antimony Town Class IVb draft landfill permit and permit application began August 19, 2010. The announcement of the public comment period appeared in *The Salt Lake Tribune*, *Deseret Morning News* and the *Garfield County Insider*. No comments were received. Accordingly, no changes to the permit were made.

Enclosed is Permit #0106R1, which expires on October 1, 2020. A public notice of the permit issuance will appear in the *Garfield County Insider*.

Representatives of the Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste and representatives of the Southwest Utah Public Health Department will conduct periodic inspections of the landfill to assess compliance with the conditions of the Permit and the *Solid Waste Permitting and Management Rules*.
