NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT
Orbital/ATK in Magna

The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control invites comment from the public on a report describing cleanup of six sites at Orbital/ATK located in Magna, Utah. The sites were originally used for disposal of industrial wastewater. Disposal of the waste water resulted in soil contamination. The contaminated soil was excavated and soil samples were collected following excavation. The soil sample results indicate the contamination was removed and these sites are now suitable for unrestricted land use as defined in R315-101 of the Utah Administrative Code.

The 30-day public comment period on the cleanup report for these six sites will commence on August 21, 2015 and end September 19, 2015. A public hearing may be held if, within 15 days of publication of this notice, a request is made to the Director in writing which meets the requirements of R315-311-3 of the Utah Administrative Code.
