The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control invites comment from the public regarding Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) S-38, SA-3 and BW-12 at the ATK/Orbital, Bacchus Facility in Magna, Utah. S-38 was a small sump used for disposal of liquid waste, SA-3 was a surface storage area and BW-12 was a landfill. The waste and contaminated soil in the landfill was removed. Based on soil and soil gas sample data collected at all three SWMUs, ATK has proposed these sites qualify for unrestricted/residential land use as defined in Utah Administrative Code R315-101.

The public comment period for S-38, SA-3 and BW-12 begins August 23, 2017 and ends September 21, 2017. A public hearing may be held if, within 15 days of publication of this notice, a request is made to the Director in writing which meets the requirements of R315-311-3.
