The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control invites comment from the public on a draft Site Management Plan (SMP). The SMP imposes certain activity and land use limitations on the property, which are necessary due to residual chlorinated solvent impacts to the soil and indoor air from the former Milo’s Cleaner.

The public comment period to receive comments on the SMP will commence on July 1, 2020 and end on July 30, 2020. A public hearing may be held if, within 15 days of publication of this notice, a request is made to the Division in writing which meets the requirements of UAC R315-311-3.
