Treatment Variance Request for Wastes Containing PCBs

The public comment period to receive comments on the Treatment Variance Request will commence on May 13, 2020 and end on June 12, 2020. A public hearing on this issue will be held upon request.

EnergySolutions is requesting an exemption from Utah Administrative Code (UAC) R315-268-40(a)(3) for waste that has been treated for hazardous waste characteristic codes, but still contains Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs) above the Universal Treatment Standard (UTS) described in R315-268-48.
