The 30-day public comment period for the Garfield County Ticaboo Class II draft landfill permit and permit application began December 24, 2008. The announcement of the public comment period appeared in *The Salt Lake Tribune*, *Deseret News* and the *Garfield County Insider*. No comments were received. Accordingly, no changes to the permit were made.

Enclosed is Permit #9203R2, which expires on January 31, 2019. A public notice of the permit issuance will appear in the same newspapers mentioned above.

Representatives of the Utah Solid and Hazardous Waste Control Board and or representatives of the Southwest Utah Public Health Department will conduct periodic inspections of the landfill. The landfill inspections are to assess compliance with the conditions of the Permit and the *Solid Waste Permitting and Management Rules*.

Pursuant to the provisions of the *Utah Solid and Hazardous Waste Act*, Title 19, Chapter 6, Part 1, Utah Code Annotated (UCA) 1953, as amended (the Act) and the *Utah Solid Waste Permitting and Management Rules*, Utah Administrative Code (UAC) R315-301 through 320 adopted thereunder,

Garfield County

is hereby approved to own and operate the Ticaboo Class II Landfill located in 1/4 section of Section 6, Township 37 south, Range 11 east, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, Garfield County, Utah as shown in the permit application that was determined complete on December 2, 2008.

The operation of the landfill is subject to the conditions that Garfield County (Permittee) meet the requirements of UAC R315-301 through 320 and the requirements set forth herein.


All references to UAC R315-301 through 320 are to regulations that are in effect on the date that this permit becomes effective.

This permit shall become effective February 1, 2009.

This permit shall expire at midnight January 31, 2019.

PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

Permit as used in this document is defined in UAC R315-301-2(55).

The application, as deemed complete on the date shown on the signature page of this permit, is hereby incorporated by reference into this Solid Waste Permit and will be referred to as the permit application throughout this permit. All representations made in the permit application are part of this permit and are enforceable under UAC 315-301-5(2). The permit application will become part of the operating record of the Landfill. Where differences in wording exist between this permit and the permit application, the wording of the permit supersedes that of the permit application.

By this permit to own and operate, the Permittee is subject to the following conditions.

I. GENERAL COMPLIANCE RESPONSIBILITIES

A. General Operation

The Permittee shall operate the landfill in accordance with all applicable requirements of UAC R315-302 and 303, for a Class II landfill, that are in effect as of the date of this permit unless otherwise noted in this permit. Any permit noncompliance or noncompliance with any applicable portions of UCA 19-6-101
