Georgia-Pacific Former Gypsum Manufacturing Facility  
200 South State Street (Utah Highway 24), Sigurd, Utah

The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control invites comments from the public on a draft Site Management Plan (SMP) and Well Abandonment Plan (WAP), developed by Georgia-Pacific, 133 Peachtree Street NE, Atlanta, Georgia, 30303. The SMP includes activity use limitations and future actions needed to manage the groundwater contamination present at the Georgia Pacific Former Gypsum Manufacturing Facility, in Sigurd, Utah. The property is also required to implement an Environmental Covenant that will be recorded in the Sevier County Recorder's Office, after approval of the SMP and WAP.

The public comment period to receive comments on the SMP will commence on Aug. 1, 2019, and end on Sept. 2, 2019. A public hearing may be held if, within 15 days of publication of this notice, a request is made to the Director in writing which meets the requirements of UAC R315-311-3.
