Hadco Construction CD Landfill

Post-Closure Plan

Site Monitoring

There are no post-closure monitoring requirements for groundwater or gas at the Hadco CD Landfill since it is a Class IVb facility. However, other physical aspects of the Landfill will be monitored on a semi-annual basis.

The Landfill topography shall be visually checked for depressions that could result in ponding or rapid erosion. Irregularities in the surface of the final cover will be regraded and revegetated as needed to protect the surface from erosion and to eliminate ponding.

Drainage on the south part of the landfill will be monitored to make sure the drainage channel remains intact and continues to function as it should. If erosion ever makes it ineffective it will be repaired to make sure it continues to direct runoff to the southeast corner of the landfill. The southeast drainage channel will be visually monitored with each site inspection to make sure it continues to function properly. Both security gates to the landfill will be monitored to make sure they remain closed and locked.

Maintenance

Post-closure maintenance activities will be completed based on any needs that are noted during site inspections. We will plan on adding additional gravel/small boulders to the southeast drainage channel to help control erosion. Any bare spots in the final cover that are noted will be reseeded. The fence around the landfill as well as the entrance gates will be monitored during site inspections and will be maintained/repared as needed. New soil will be brought in and installed in the event of any settling. That new soil will be reseeded as soon as it is installed. Straw erosion rolls/bales will be maintained to help control the erosion of the ditch on the south part of the landfill.

Hadco Construction has maintained and will continue to maintain a \$33,000 letter of credit in favor of the Utah Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control as financial assurance that the above-mentioned maintenance items will be maintained.

Record Modification

The Utah County Recorder will be provided a plat and a statement of fact concerning the location of any disposal site. The statement of fact and the plat shall be recorded. The notation will serve to notify any potential purchaser of the property that the land has been used as a landfill, and that its use may be restricted by local land use or zoning regulations. Utah County will notify the Executive Secretary that the deed notation has been recorded.
