Dear Mr. Bay.:

Enclosed is a NOTICE OF VIOLATION (NOV) based on the failure of Jordan Valley Water Conservancy District to submit a timely Sampling and Analysis Plan for the State Painting (Jenstate) property as ordered. Because of this lack of timeliness, the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control spent public resources to further characterize the dusty spent blast media that had been wasted at the surface of the property and thereby discovered the existence of an immediate public health problem that resulted in an EPA-directed emergency response action under the Superfund program. Had the Sampling and Analysis Plan been submitted in a timely manner as ordered, the existence of this emergency public health situation would have been known sooner and the Division and EPA would have been able to undertake more timely actions.

You have 30 days from the date of this NOV to contest it in the manner and within the time period prescribed by R305-7-303 of the Utah Administrative Code.
