The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control invites comment from the public on a revised Site Management Plan (SMP) developed by the Larsen Family Trust. The SMP has been revised to allow for removal of all groundwater sampling wells and the elimination of the requirement for groundwater sampling at the property. The revised SMP includes updated information for current and future use limitations needed to manage the groundwater contamination at the property.

The public comment period to receive comments on the SMP will commence on July 3, 2019 and end on August 1, 2019. A public hearing may be held if, within 15 days of publication of this notice, a request is made to the Director in writing which meets the requirements of UAC 315-311-3.
