**NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT  
LISBON VALLEY MINING COMPANY CLASS IVb LANDFILL**

The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control is seeking public comment on a Draft Class IVb Landfill Permit for Lisbon Valley Mining Company site that will allow landfilling on 4.8 acres. The permit will allow the landfilling of wastes that is only generated by the mine operations that comprise the following waste streams: Construction and Demolition waste, Yard Waste and Contaminated Soils that don't meet the definition of a hazardous waste. The permit application has been determined to be complete and compliant with the Utah Solid Waste Permitting and Management Rules. A draft permit has been prepared.

The public comment period to receive comments on the permit renewal application will commence on June 14, 2019 and end on July 15, 2019. Documents related to this application can be reviewed at the following locations:
