Peck Rock and Development Class VI Landfill Permit draft

Peck Rock and Products submitted a permit application to renew their permit to operate the Peck Rock and Products Class VI Landfill in Saratoga Springs, Utah. The proposed permit application was reviewed and has been determined to be complete and in compliance with the Utah Solid Waste Permitting and Management Rules. A permit was drafted (Permit draft) which allows the facility to continue to operate the Peck Rock and Products Class VI Landfill for ten years once a final permit is approved. The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control is currently seeking public comment on the Permit draft.

The public comment period to receive comments on the Permit draft will commence on March 8, 2021 and end on April 6, 2021.
