

## PUBLIC NOTICE

Public Notice is hereby given on January 29, 2019 that Pennzoil-Quaker State Company dba Shell Oil Products, US (SOPUS) has filed a copy of the modified Post-Closure Permit for the Former Pennzoil Refinery, Roosevelt, Utah with the Utah Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control. The original Permit was issued to Pennzoil-Quaker State in December 1992 with a renewal in June 2004, a Permit Modification in August 2009, and a Permit Renewal in September 2014 and this current Permit Modification.

Pennzoil-Quaker State Company dba SOPUS Products submitted a request for a Class 2 Permit Modification to the Division. The primary purpose of these modifications are to 1) accommodate changes by the Division in the frequency and analyses of groundwater monitoring, 2) revise and update the Emergency Call List, and 3) remove Attachment 5, Sampling and Analysis Plan (SAP) from the permit to make the SAP a standalone document.

The 60-day comment period for this modification will end on March 30, 2019 or with 60 days of the initial date of publication of this notice, whichever comes later.
