

V. MODULE V - GROUNDWATER CORRECTIVE ACTION

V.A. CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN

V.A.1. The Permittees shall submit a Corrective Action Plan (CAP) for any contamination associated with the Waste Disposal Cell (WDC) within 180 days of the notification to the Director in accordance with Condition IV.G.1 and R315-101 of Utah Admin. Code. Upon submittal of the CAP, the Director will review the plan and either approve or disapprove the CAP. If the CAP is not approved, Pennzoil – Quaker State Company will provide corrective solutions to the CAP deficiencies specified in writing by the Director within 90 days of the written notification.

V.B. CORRECTIVE ACTION IMPLEMENTATION

V.B.1. Upon approval of the CAP by the Director, the Permittees shall implement the CAP.

V.C. DURATION OF CORRECTIVE ACTION PROGRAM

V.C.1. The Permittees shall continue to implement the CAP during the compliance period to the extent necessary to ensure that the groundwater protection standard is not exceeded. If the Permittees are conducting corrective action at the end of the compliance period, they shall continue that corrective action for as long as necessary to achieve compliance with the groundwater protection standard. The Permittee may terminate the CAP if the Permittees can demonstrate, with Director's approval, based on data from the groundwater monitoring program under Module IV, that the corrective action objectives have been met in accordance with the approved CAP and R315-101-6 of Utah Admin. Code.
