NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT ON
RICH COUNTY LANDFILL DRAFT PERMIT RENEWAL

The Director of the Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is seeking public comment on a request by Rich County to renew the solid waste permit for its Class II municipal landfill at the existing site approximately one mile west of Sage Creek Junction north of State Route 30. The permit renewal application has been reviewed for compliance with the Solid Waste Permitting and Management Rules and a draft permit has been prepared.

The public comment period to receive comments on the permit renewal will commence on February 6, 2014 and end on March 10, 2014. A public hearing may be held if, within 15 days of publication of this notice, a request is made to the Director in writing which meets the requirements of R315-311-3 of the Utah Administrative Code.
