RN Industries has submitted a permit application to operate a Class IIIb Oil and Gas Exploration and Production Waste Landfill at the RN Industries disposal facility at 6878 Bluebell Road, Roosevelt, Utah 84066. Class IIIb Oil and Gas Exploration and Production Waste landfills accept only oil and gas exploration and production waste. The permit application has been reviewed by the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control for compliance with the Solid Waste Management Rules and a draft permit has been prepared by the Director of Waste Management and Radiation Control. The Director is soliciting comments on the permit application and the draft permit in relation to their compliance with the Solid Waste Management Rules. R315-311-3 of the Utah Administrative Code requires a public comment period to receive comments on the draft permit prior to final action by the Director.

The public comment period to receive comments on the draft permit will commence on June 26, 2019 and end on July 26, 2019.
