NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT
LANDFILL EXPANSION
SAN JUAN COUNTY CLASS I LANDFILL

San Juan County has asked for approval for the design and development of waste cells 5 and 6 for the San Juan County Class I landfill located 11 miles south of Blanding, Utah on State Route 262. The landfill expansion of cells 5 and 6 will expand the disposal capacity of the landfill by approximately 601,670 cubic yards of available space. The proposed landfill cell design for the Class I landfill has been reviewed and determined to be complete and is in compliance with the Utah Solid Waste Permitting and Management Rules.

The public comment period for the proposed waste cell design and expansion begins on February 7, 2019 and will end March 8, 2019.
