NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT ON
Draft Renewal Permit
Sevier County Sage Flat Class I and IV Landfill

Sevier County has submitted a permit renewal application to continue to operate its Class I and IV landfill east of Highway 24 on the Sage Flat Road, Sevier, County, Utah. The landfill will continue to receive non-hazardous solid waste. The renewal permit application has been reviewed by the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control for compliance with the Solid Waste Management Rules and a draft permit has been prepared by the Director of Waste Management and Radiation Control. The Director is soliciting comments on the draft permit. R315-311-3 of the Utah Administrative Code provides for a public comment period to receive comments on the renewal application and draft permit prior to final action by the director.

The public comment period to receive comments on the draft permit will commence on October 24, 2019 and end on November 25, 2019.
