NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT

The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control is seeking public comment on the verification of closure for the temporary Open Burn/Open Detonation (OB/OD) area at Tooele Army Depot-South Area (TEADS). The OB/OD area at TEADS was used for treatment of explosive waste removed during remediation activities. Soil sampling data collected following the treatment indicate the OB/OD areas qualify for industrial land-use as defined in R315-101 of the Utah Administrative Code.

The public comment period for the OB/OD area closure verification begins August 4, 2017 and ends September 5, 2017. A public hearing may be held if, within 15 days of publication of this notice, if a request is made to the Director in writing which meets the requirements of R315-311-3 of the Utah Administrative Code.
