Tooele Army Depot South Area (TEAD-S)  
Class 3 Modification Request – Corrective Action Modifications

<b>Proposed action</b>	<p>The Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control (DWMRC) is proposing to approve a Class 3 permit modification request to update the Corrective Action Program at the Tooele Army Depot South Area (TEAD-S). TEAD-S submitted the modification request on January 23, 2020. This modification adds new Post-Closure Plans to the Permit for Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) going into post-closure; makes administrative changes to existing Post-Closure Permits to update references to the Utah Administrative Code; and removes closed Areas of Concern (AOCs) that met risk-based closure. A draft of the modified permit has been prepared and is available for public comment.</p>
<b>When is the public hearing?</b>	<p>The DWMRC will hold a virtual Public Hearing with Google Hangouts at 6:00 pm, on Wednesday, May 20, 2020. <b>How long is the public comment period?</b>	<p>In accordance with R315-124-10(b) UAC, the public is allowed 45 days to review the draft approval and submit comments. The public comment period to receive comments on the draft approval will commence on April 24, 2020, and end on June 8, 2020.</p>

Under Utah Code Section 19-1-301.5 a person who wishes to challenge a permit order may only raise an issue or argument during an adjudicatory proceeding that was raised during the public comment period and was supported with sufficient information or documentation to enable the director to fully consider the substance and significance of the issue.</p>
